LADIES AND GENTLEMEN

The 31st International Defence Industry Exhibition was truly exceptional in all its aspects; the show brought together 711 exhibitors from 35 countries, including 350 Polish companies. The trade fair hosted 61 delegations from 43 countries. The 2023 MSPO exhibition used a record-breaking exhibition area of over 34,000 sq m. For the first time in its history, MSPO display was also located in an additional temporary hall of 2,800 sq m. Amost 26,000 guests from all over the world attended MSPO 2023. MSPO was vi-

sited by President Andrzej Duda, who has granted his honorary auspices to the Expo. In addition to the President, the event was also graced with the presence of Prime Minister Mateusz Morawiecki and Mariusz Błaszczak, Minister of National Defence and Jacek Siewiera, the head of the National Security Bureau. Korea was featured as the Lead Nation Exhibition; the Korean delegation was headed by Eom Dong-hwan, the Minister of Defense Acquisition Program Administration (DAPA), of the Republic of Korea. The commanding staff of the Polish Army also took part in the event.

Serving the country's security, increasing access to global technologies, and exchanging ideas and experiences - the organisers of the MSPO have found these overriding objectives pivotal since the first expo unveiling. Contracts and agreements worth PLN 155 billion were signed at the four-day expo expo. I am convinced that the mission we undertook over three decades ago is still successfully implemented.

I would like to express my gratitude to those who have contributed to this success. At the opening ceremony, the President of the Polish Armaments Group, Mr. Sebastian Chwałek, said that the International Defence Industry Exhibition is the effort of many people. I do agree with this statement. From my perspective, not only does this opinion concern us, the expo organisers, but also Exhibitors, soldiers who prepare and execute the Armed Forces Exhibition, official guests who have supported MSPO and have been involved in MSPO idea out of concern for the country's safety and security.



KOREAN ACHIEVEMENTS PRE-SENTED IN TARGI KIELCE

The MSPO 2023 Lead Nation Exhibition featured South Korea. This Asian country was appointed the MSPO Lead Nation role for the second time.

Korea's military potential was presented at the 25th anniversary MSPO for the first time. The choice of South Korea in 2023 was almost obvious.

The Program Board's proposal and then the decision of the Ministry of National Defence to invite the Republic of Korea to organize the Lead Nation Exhibition was a natural step. The Polish government has resolved to purchase extensive military equipment from Korea. The agreements were also signed at 2022's defence industry trade show in Kielce.

The Korean display included equipment ordered by the Polish army, such as Chunmoo missile launchers and K2 tanks, which the Polish Armed Forces will soon use. The modern vehicle assortment also included the K808 wheeled armoured vehicle, the UGV multi--purpose uncrewed ground vehicles, as well as mock-ups of defence unmanned aerial vehicles and unmanned land vehicles. The exhibition also included a light tactical reconnaissance vehicle - KLTV Reconnaissance, and the armoured, tactical hydrogen-powered ATV

vehicle, FA-50 light combat aircraft, which will also serve in the Polish Armed Forces, and the KF-21 multi-role fighter prototype (presented as mock-ups).

31 companies presented the Korean defence industry's potential. The Korean expo presentation was complemented by a show of taekwondo masters and performances by the Naval Orchestra, accompanied by dancers in traditional dragon outfits.

Jong-Sup Lee, the Minister of National Defence of the Republic of South Korea, visited the Kielce exhibition and congress centre the week preceding the MSPO commencement. The Korean delegation headed by the Minister met President Andrzej Mochon and the task force of the International Defence Industry Exhibition. The Minister visited the expo stands of Hyundai-Rotem and Hanhwa, still under construction, during his expo tour.

















CONTRACTS WORTH BILLIONS

Agreements worth nearly PLN 155 billion were concluded at Targi Kielce's event.



PLN 100 billion is the value of the contracts approved by the Minister of National Defence Mariusz Błaszczak. Contracts concluded between the State Treasury and the government of the United States of America concerning the purchase of elements of the WISŁA anti-aircraft and anti-missile defence system were also signed during MSPO. Poland will obtain 12 omnidirectional LTAMDS radars, 48 launchers of the PATRIOT M903 system and a supply of PAC-3 MSE missiles. Other agreements relate to the supply of the Narew and Pilica+ programs' compnents, NSM anti-ship missiles for the next two squadrons and Fly-Eye reconnaissance drones. 1,700 of these unmanned aerial vehicles are to be delivered by WB Electronics.

About 20 contracts and agreements were concluded by the Polish Armaments Group on the first three days of the Show, including financially binding ones worth PLN 54.1 billion. PLN 100 million of this amount has been earmarked for Mesko in Skarżysko for ammunition supplies, including anti-aircraft missiles. Some of the agreements signed during MSPO will soon translate into actual, financial values; and

among them is the contract for the production of American Javelin anti-tank missiles in Mesko. The Skar-żysko-based company will be the first foreign plant where Javelins will be produced; the contract value is expected to reach hundreds of millions of PLN.

At Targi Kielce, PGZ has also officially acquired cooperation partners. These partnerships will result in the development of new technologies. As a result of the agreement with Military Communication Works No. 1 SA and the Polish ICEYE company, the operator of radar satellites, a constellation of radar satellites with a stationary and mobile ground station are to be prepared for the use of the Polish Armed Forces. This solution is intended to revolutionize the information collection and decision-making system in frontline operations. The real-time image will be transmitted via satellites to the command and control centre.

The agreement concluded between the Łukasiewicz Institute of Aviation and the Polish company Jakusz also reaches out to space - the collaboration will result in ecological and high-performance space propellants, i.e. rocket fuel.



MSPO - DISCUSSION ARENA FOR IMPORTANT TOPICS

The International Defence Industry Exhibition was complemented by knowledge-packed meetings. 2023 show witnessed 38 seminars, briefings, conferences and debates.

The list of most essential events MSPO 2023 accompanying includes the debate organised by the Ministry of Development and Technology on "Transforming the European Defence Industry", which brought participants - Polish and European experts in the field of defence and development. In the course of the discussion, the experts also referred to specific tools at the disposal of the European Union in the context of the development of the defence industry. Thanks to the expertise of the high-level speakers, the event allowed its participants to set a strategy related to the directions and dynamics of the development of the European defence industry.

Also, the National Security Office organised a strategic debate devoted to logistics processes in the Polish army. – There is no better place than Targi Kielce to discuss such a key issue, which requires expertise. The MSPO witnesses the visible and tangible change in the technological quality of the equipment - said the head of the National Security Bureau, Minister Jacek Siewiera. Army Generals and defence sector experts took part in the discussion.

The Polish Armed Forces exhibition has been an inherent part of MSPO for 24 years. This year's mi-

litary exhibition was held under the banner of "New equipment - new challenges - new opportunities". All armed forces branches, military universities and scientific institutes presented their latest achievements and equipment. The exhibition halls and the outdoor exhibition grounds were the display for M1A1 Abrams tanks, K-2 Black Panther, Leopard 2 PL, 155-mm Krab howitzer, 155-mm K9A1 self-propelled artillery howitzer, M142 Homar A/HI-MARS missile launcher, Baobab scattered mine laying vehicle, M903 A1 Patriot launcher and Skyctrl anti-drone system. The Exhibition of the Polish Armed Forces was organised by the General Staff of the Polish Armed Forces for the fifth time. The Inspectorate of Support for the Armed Forces was responsible for the preparation and coordination of all activities and, thus, the participation of military units in the exhibition.

Important events marked the MSPO agenda, and among them, the gala Inauguration of the School Year for Uniformed Classes graced with the presence of the Minister of National Defence. There was also the gala signing of an agreement between Targi Kielce and the Al Worden Endeavor Scholarship Foundation. An explosion-proof Wiktoria container by Jakusz on a Zasław chassis was officially presented to police pyrotechnicians from Ukraine.
