The First Edition of PLASTPOL

- Humble beginnings – the event primarily focused on Polish manufacturers and distributors of plastics processing machinery.
- Organized at that time in a much smaller exhibition space.

Early 2000s

Rapid Growth and Internationalization

- Growing interest from foreign companies, particularly from Germany, Italy, Austria, and the Czech Republic.
- The fair begins to be seen as a “gateway to Eastern Europe” for global brands in the plastics sector.

Partnership with International Industry Organizations

- Collaboration with VDMA (German Engineering Federation), Assocomplast (Italy), and APIP (Polish Chamber of Chemical Industry).
- Strengthening the event's position as an international B2B platform.

2010

PLASTPOL Becomes the Largest Industry Event in Central and Eastern Europe

- Over 700 exhibitors from nearly 30 countries.
- Companies from China, Korea, India, and Turkey participate – PLASTPOL becomes a meeting point between East and West.

2017

20th Anniversary of PLASTPOL

- Record-breaking attendance and the highest number of live machine demonstrations to date.
- Expansion of key thematic zones: recycling, bioplastics, process automation, and robotics.

2020

Challenges of the COVID-19 Pandemic

- Cancellation of the traditional event date – adaptation to new realities.
- Enhanced online activities and digital communication with exhibitors and visitors.

2022-2023

Full-Scale Return and Visitor Recovery

- Asian exhibitors return, alongside growing participation from companies in Turkey, Switzerland, and the Nordic region.
- Focus areas include sustainability, the circular economy, and smart factory technologies.

2024

Forum for Green Industrial Transformation

- An expanded conference agenda featuring key players such as European Plastics Converters and PlasticsEurope.
- First-time showcases of energy-saving machinery and cutting-edge recycling technologies.
