MEDIA COVERAGE





The 32nd International Defence Industry Exhibition was truly exceptional; the show brought together 769 companies from 33 countries, including 353 Polish firms. Over 28 thousand people from around the world, two thousand more than last year, were presented with the latest defence technologies and solutions. This group also included 65 foreign delegations from 47 countries, and among them Australia, Belgium, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, the Philippines, France, India, Indonesia, Japan, Canada, South Korea,

Malaysia, Serbia, the United States, Sweden, Turkey, Ukraine, Italy and Bangladesh.

Since the first MSPO, the event has been a strategic trade show for our country. In 1999, for example, thanks to the support of the Chief of General Staff, the exhibition of the Armed Forces was prepared at the Kielce Expo for the first time to celebrate Poland's accession to the North Atlantic Treaty Organization. This year's Expo witnessed the anniversary Exhibition held under the banner of Poland; 25 years in NATO, safe and secure for 25 years.

The Exhibition's importance is also emphasised by the presence of the country's most influential people, who were hosted at Targi Kielce. Following many-year example MSPO was graced with the presence of many official guests, including the President of the Republic of Poland, Mr. Andrzej Duda. On both the first and last day of the event, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of National Defence Władysław Kosiniak-Kamysz participated in the show. The event was also visited by Tomasz Siemoniak, Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration, and many other ministers, members of parliament, representatives of the provincial authorities and the city of Kielce, headed by the Mayor of Kielce, Agata Wojda. It is also worth adding that Mr. Szymon Hołownia was the first Speaker of the Sejm in the Expo's history to visit Targi Kielce and attend the opening of MSPO.

I would like to thank the commanders and soldiers who prepared and served in the Armed Forces Exhibition, and I owe gratitude to the strategic partner of the Expo, the Polish Armaments Group. I want to thank all exhibitors who treat the Expo participation as an important mission and always emerge victorious.

Next year, we will meet at MSPO in a slightly different reality because of the expo hall construction, which will begin in spring. I assure you, however - you will not even notice this process. The Targi Kielce team will go the extra mile to ensure that next year's Expo meets all expectations. The International Defence Industry Exhibition 2026 turns a new page in our history.

AGREEMENTS AND CONTRACTS SIGNED AT MSPO

The trade fair witnessed numerous MOU's, contracts and cooperation agreements signed with leading representatives of Poland's and global defence industry. Minister Władysław Kosiniak-Kamysz, at the press conference on the last day of the trade fair, recapitulated that the 32nd MSPO witnessed contracts worth approximately PLN 2 billion signed.

The Armaments Agency signed five contracts, including those with the Spanish Indra Sistemas, for delivering 15 systems, which soldiers servicing military airports are awaiting; the contract value is PLN 1.1 billion.

WB Electronics will supply of FlyEye Miniature Unmanned Aerial Systems sets; the contract value is 24 million PLN.

The contract covers the delivery of 31 radio receivers for anti-aircraft and anti-missile systems, intended for the medium-range Wisła and short-range Narew systems. The value of this contract is approximately \$16.7 million. Subsequent agreements of key importance also boosted the development of the defence industry, many of them were concluded behind the scenes.

KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCES EXCHANGE - CONFERENCES, SEMINARS, DEBATES

The International Defence Industry Exhibition abounds with seminars and conferences. This year, as many as 45 such meetings were held within the scope of the Expo.

On the second day of this year's International Defence Industry Exhibition, the editorial team of the Defence24.pl portal arranged the debate on: „Polish Soldier's Modern Uniforms - Ethos, Safety and Functionality” attended by representatives of the military, including the 1st Deputy Commander of the Territorial Defence Forces, Brigadier General Grzegorz Barabieda, Anna Zygany from Milliken & Company and General Ben Hodges, former commanding general of the United States Army in Europe. The event discussed issues important from the point of view of users – soldiers. Functionality and solutions and technologies used in uniforms were discussed and complemented with abundance of references to the so-called „Operation Gear” and the Advanced Individual Combat System (IISW) Tytan programme.

The seminar „The Modern Battlefield as a Determinant of the Development of Artillery Systems” presented solutions that are already in operation or will be implemented soon. The conference

was organised by the Polish Armaments Group and Huta Stalowa Wola.

The 2nd Scientific Conference „Science for Defence and Security MSPO 2024” was held at the Congress Centre; the Kielce University of Technology arranged the meeting.

The Was Studies University invited participants to an expert debate devoted to the „contemporary NATO strategic concept”; the prospects for cooperation after the enlargement of the Alliance were discussed.

The Department of Trade and International Cooperation of the Ministry of Development Funds and Regional Policy offered a training course - „Become a supplier to the US Army stationed in Poland”. The meeting was an excellent platform for gaining knowledge and contacts for Polish entrepreneurs from industries cooperating with the army and uniformed services.

YEARS OF THE POLISH ARMED FORCES' EXHIBITION



For 25 years, the Armed Forces Exhibition has accompanied the International Defence Industry Exhibition in Targi Kielce. This is the traditional arena in which the Polish military shows its potential. For many years in a row, the Polish Armed Forces Exhibition has been organised and arranged by the Chief of the General Staff of the Polish Armed Forces. The Head of the Inspectorate for Armed Forces Support is responsible for implementing the entire undertaking and co-ordinating activities related to military units of the Polish Armed Forces participating in the Polish Armed Forces Exhibition.

The Jubilee XXV Armed Forces Exhibition presented the most modern military equipment introduced to the Polish Armed Forces, and se-

lected elements of logistic support for troops, laboratories, and didactic purposes. Kielce has traditionally hosted all types and branches of armed forces, complemented with cyberspace defence forces, the Military Police and military institutions, e.g. Operational Command of the Armed Forces Branches, General Command of the Armed Forces, Inspectorate of Armed Forces Support and Central Military Recruitment Centre.

This year's theme refers to the 25th anniversary of Poland's accession to the North Atlantic Alliance - „Poland; 25 years in NATO, safe and secure for 25 years”.

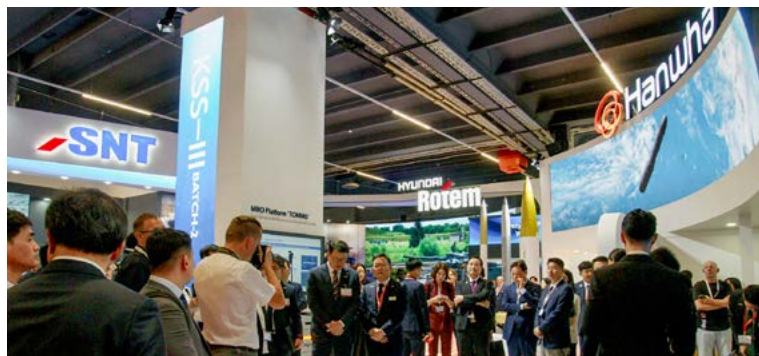

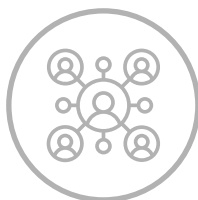

Polski przemysł obronny idzie w świat



Jedną z eksportowych ofert są polskie drony

Podczas Międzynarodowego Salonu Przemysłu Obronnego zaprezentowano katalog uzbrojenia, które polskie firmy chcą sprzedawać za granicą.

MATERIAŁ POWSTAŁ W WSPÓŁPRACY Z TARGAMI KIELCE

„The Polish Defence and Security Equipment Catalogue”, bo tak zatytułowany jest katalog, ma pomóc rodzimym spółkom w podboju zagranicznych rynków. Jego powstanie to efekt współpracy Ministerstwa Obrony Narodowej, Biura Bezpieczeństwa Narodowego oraz firm polskiego sektora obronnego.

Publikacja obejmuje łącznie ponad 200 produktów 61 firm i znajdziemy w nim wszystko to, co ma najlepsze do zaoferowania nasz przemysł obronny. Katalog obejmuje całą gamę produktów. Od ciężkiego sprzętu, takiego jak pojazdy opancerzone czy systemy artyleryjskie, po wysoko wyspecjalizowane produkty i usługi z zakresu cyberbezpieczeństwa, łączności czy rozpoznania.

Trzeba podkreślić, że jest to inicjatywa jak najbardziej potrzebna. Kwestia eksportu uzbrojenia to największa pięta achillesowa polskiego przemysłu. Teraz pojawia się nadzieja, że to wkrótce się zmieni.

Kupujemy dużo, chcemy też dużo sprzedawać

Co oznacza publikacja katalogu dla polskich spółek przemysłu obronnego? Z deklaracji złożonych podczas MSPO w Kielcach wynika, że naprawdę dużo.

– Macie pełne wsparcie rządu Rzeczypospolitej Polski w działaniach, które prowadzicie – powiedział podczas konferencji prasowej Władysław Kosiniak-Kamysz, wicepremier i minister obrony narodowej, wyjaśniając, jaka idea stoi za najnowszą publikacją MON.

– Jesteśmy na MSPO w Kielcach, jednym z najważniejszych wydarzeń związanych z przemysłem obronnym. I chcemy tu dzisiaj bardzo wyraźnie powiedzieć naszym partnerom z zagranicy. Dużo kupiliśmy, teraz chcemy bardzo dużo sprze-

dać. Ten katalog ma nam to umożliwić – podkreślał.

Słowa szefa MON nie są na wyrost. Polska w ostatnich latach wyrwała na niekwestionowanego lidera wśród państw NATO wydatkach na obronność. W tym roku przeznaczymy na ten cel około 4 proc. PKB, co jest wynikiem dwukrotnie wyższym niż wymagane w sojuszu 2 proc. Wartość ta będzie tylko rosła. Obecnie szacuje się, że w przyszłym roku wskaźnik ten wzrośnie do poziomu 4,7 proc. PKB. To ogromne pieniądze i gdyby choć tylko część wróciła do kraju w formie eksportu, jest o co walczyć.

Publikacja katalogu oznacza, że przed polskimi urzędnikami nowe zadanie.

200 ofert

zawiera przygotowany po raz pierwszy katalog polskiego przemysłu obronnego

61 firm

prezentuje swoje produkty w wydawnictwie, które ma trafić do zagranicznych klientów

– Będziemy się promować – powiedział szef MON zapewniając, że „The Polish Defence and Security Equipment Catalogue” będzie towarzyszył przedstawicielom MON na każdym wyjeździe zagranicznym. Katalog otrzymają także wszystkie polskie ambassy oraz attache wojskowe z zadaniem jego przedstawiania oraz promowania.

Bezpieczeństwo celem nadrzędnym

Jacek Siewiera, szef Biura Bezpieczeństwa Narodowego, podziękował za przyjęcie zaproszenia do współpracy. W wystąpieniu podkreślił także, że omawiana publikacja to ważny krok w dobrą stronę.

– Przygotowanie tego katalogu to przykład myślenia o bezpieczeństwie kraju. Bezpieczeństwo rozumianym nie tylko jako zdolność do rażenia celów i obrony wojsk własnych, ale także jako zdolność do produkcji, zabezpieczenia materiałowego sił zbrojnych oraz budowy właściwej pozycji eksportowej i zdolności ekonomicznych – powiedział.

Czy Polska zbuduje takie zdolności? Zdaniem szefa

BBN musimy. Mamy odpowiedni potencjał, by to uczynić.

– Kraj, który wydaje 4 proc. PKB na obronność, a w perspektywie czasu być może nawet 5 proc. nie ma wyboru. Musi rozwinąć swój przemysł obronny. Jak pokazują przykłady z Korei Południowej, Turcji czy Izraela rozwinięcie takiego przemysłu w perspektywie dekad jest nie tylko możliwe. Jest koniecznością – mówił Siewiera.

– Polski katalog, który jako pierwszy zbiera zagregowaną wiedzę o biznesie i z rynku i nie różni na podmioty państwowe i prywatne. Wszystkie podmioty otrzymają wsparcie. To bardzo istotny sygnał dla naszych producentów, którzy zatrud-

niali polskie kadry na polskiej ziemi, którzy posiadają polskie łańcuchy dostaw z polskimi surowcami do tego, by oferować swoje produkty zagranicą – podkreślał.

Na koniec wystąpienia szef BBN odniósł się do historii. – Nigdy więcej w historii Rzeczypospolitej nie możemy doprowadzić do sytuacji takiej, jak przed II Wojną Światową.
