

# **REGULATIONS**

of the Competition for Medals and Distinctions of Targi Kielce at the 13th Gas Technology Fair EXPO-GAS 2025, 08 - 10 April 2025

## **I. Competition Organizers.**

The organizers of the competition are Targi Kielce and the Chamber of Commerce of Gas Industry.

## **II. The purpose of the Competition**

The purpose of the contest is to promote the best, innovative products presented at the 13th Gas Technology Fair EXPO-GAS in Kielce, as well as other modern solutions that can accelerate the development of the gas sector.

## **III. Conditions of Participation in the Competition.**

1. The Competition is open to any company that has registered for participation in the EXPO-GAS 2025 Gas Technology Fair in Kielce and made a handling payment of PLN 800 net for each product entered into the competition to the account: Bank BGŻ BNP Paribas S.A. S.A. PL 22 1750 1110 0000 0000 0568 3537
2. The condition for accepting a product into the competition is also to add an entry in the customer portal / <https://portalklienta.targikielce.pl/auth/login> / in the "competition" tab by the deadline of 31 MARCH 2025, 3:00 p.m. Each exhibitor may enter any number of products into the Competition.
3. The product entered into the Competition should be placed at the Entrant's stand and provided with the information "Product entered into the Competition". Models, miniatures, mock-ups, photographs of products, etc. cannot be entered into the Competition. This requirement does not apply to large-sized products, which due to their significant external dimensions cannot be exhibited during the Fair.
4. Entry into the Competition is tantamount to expressing consent to the free use of the information and photos provided in publications by Targi Kielce and IGG and the media cooperating with them.

## **IV. Categories of products submitted to the Competition.**

- Equipment for gas exploration, extraction, storage and transmission
- Measuring instruments
- Control equipment
- Equipment and components for the construction of gas networks
- Equipment for new gas applications
- Information technology (IT)
- Investments
- Services
- Other.

Applications in the "Investments" category may be submitted by the Investor or by the Investor together with the Contractor.

## **V. Criteria and assessment scale.**

The Jury will evaluate products submitted to the competition in terms of:

- functional and utility features,
- innovativeness of the solutions used,
- economic aspects,
- environmental protection aspects,
- serviceability and repairability,
- external features and aesthetics,

The Jury may also establish other evaluation criteria.

## **VI. Jury.**

1. The Jury is appointed by Targi Kielce and the Gas Chamber of Commerce.
2. The Jury deliberates under the leadership of the Jury Chairman, elected from among the Jury members, and the secretariat and office support are provided by Targi Kielce.
3. Targi Kielce, together with IGG, may appoint experts whose task would be to prepare opinions on the submitted products in individual competition categories and who may participate in the Jury meetings with an advisory vote.
4. The first Jury meeting, convened by the Chairman, will be held in Warsaw or remotely by April 4, 2025. The next Jury meetings will be held during the Fair, on April 8, 2025.
5. All materials and activities of the Jury are confidential and will not be made available to third parties.
6. The Jury may omit from the evaluation products that do not have the appropriate documents or require long-term specialist tests enabling the assessment of the product's features.
7. The Jury awards Medals and Distinctions in individual competition categories by voting at a meeting on April 8, 2025. The Jury meetings are recorded.
8. The results will be announced and the Medals and Distinctions will be presented during the Gala Evening on April 9, 2025.

## **VII. Awards**

1. The main award in each category is the Kielce Trade Fair Medal. The distinctions are diplomas funded by Kielce Trade Fairs.
2. The Jury has the right to award more than one medal or distinction in a given category
3. The Jury has the right to award a greater number of medals or distinctions than the number of categories.
