



RULES AND REGULATIONS

Targi Kielce Medals and Distinction Awards Competition during the 18th International Fair of Public Transport TRANSEXPO October 14-16, 2026

I. Competition Organisers

The Competition is organised by Targi Kielce S.A. in cooperation with the Economic Chamber of Urban Transport (IGKM) based in Warsaw.

II. Objective of the Competition

The objective of the Competition is to promote the best products presented during the 18th International Fair of Public Transport TRANSEXPO in Kielce.

III. Conditions for Entry

1. The Competition is open to any company that has registered its participation in the 18th International Fair of Public Transport TRANSEXPO in Kielce and paid a entry fee of PLN 1,200 + 23% VAT for each product submitted. The competition fee is non-refundable in the event of withdrawal from the Competition.
2. Products submitted for the competition must be registered via the Customer Portal by October 5, 2026 (Monday). Each exhibitor may submit any number of products.
3. An authorized representative of the company submitting the product must present the item during the Jury session, providing additional information and answering questions regarding the product. Details regarding the location, date, and time of the presentation will be sent via email to the address provided in the Customer Portal. Along with the submission, the exhibitor is required to upload photos of the product and the company logo to the Customer Portal. Incomplete applications (i.e., those missing product photos or company logos) will not be considered. These materials will be used by the organisers during the Medals and Distinctions Award Ceremony.
4. The product entered into the Competition should be displayed at the Applicant's stand and marked with an information tag reading "Product entered in the Competition" ("Wyrób zgłoszony do Konkursu"). However, due to size limitations, it is permissible to display parts or components of the product at the stand. In such cases, to ensure an accurate evaluation, the application should be supplemented with items such as scale models, miniatures, mock-ups, photos, videos, technical drawings, descriptions, certificates, or reference letters.



5. Submission of an entry to the Competition constitutes consent to the free use of the provided information and photos for promotional, informational, and archival purposes related to the organization of the Competition, the TRANSEXPO fair, and the activity of the Organisers.

IV. Product Categories

- Buses
- Bus parts and equipment
- Technical infrastructure
- Passenger service systems (including: information, safety, network planning)
- Fare collection systems
- Other (e.g., environmental protection)

V. Evaluation Criteria and Scale

Products submitted to the Competition will be evaluated by the Jury based on the following criteria:

- Utility and functional qualities,
- Modernity of applied solutions,
- Serviceability and repairability,
- External appearance and aesthetics.

The Jury may also establish additional evaluation criteria.

VI. The Jury

1. The Competition Committee is appointed by the organisers of the TRANSEXPO Fair – Targi Kielce S.A. and the Economic Chamber of Urban Transport (IGKM).

The Jury consists of:

- Representatives of the Supervisory Board of the Economic Chamber of Urban Transport (IGKM),
 - President of the Economic Chamber of Urban Transport (IGKM),
 - Representative of the Polish Chamber of Commercial Road Transport and Forwarding (PIGTSiS),
 - Representative of the Polish Coach Transport Association (PSPA),
 - Representative(s) of the Polish scientific community related to public transport (invited as needed).
2. The Jury deliberates under the leadership of the Jury Chairman, elected from among its members. Targi Kielce ensures secretariat support and administrative services.



3. Targi Kielce together with IGKM may appoint experts to prepare evaluation opinions on submitted products in individual competition categories. These experts may participate in Jury sessions in an advisory capacity.
4. Jury meetings will take place on October 13, 2026 (Tuesday – the day before the fair) and October 14, 2026 (Wednesday – the first day of the fair).
5. All materials and activities of the Jury are confidential and will not be disclosed to third parties.
6. The Jury may exclude products from evaluation if they lack proper documentation or require prolonged specialized testing to assess their qualities.
7. Medals and Distinctions in individual categories are awarded by the Jury by vote during the session on October 14, 2026. Minutes are taken at all Jury sessions.
8. Announcement of the results and presentation of the Medals and Distinctions will take place on October 14, 2026.

VII. Awards

1. The main award in each category is the Medal of Targi Kielce S.A. Distinctions take the form of diplomas funded by Targi Kielce S.A. - the organiser of the Competition.
2. The Jury reserves the right not to award Medals or Distinctions in specific categories.
3. Winners of Medals and Distinctions have the right to mark the awarded products with the image of the award.
